Farmington Crew Rowing for Pieces

The Farmington High School (FHS) Crew Team in Farmington Connecticut launched *Rowing for Pieces presented by Farmington Bank*; a new initiative to support Autism Speaks. The team will be selling puzzle pieces to be affixed on a new boat purchased specifically for this purpose.

Rowing for Pieces was launched on May 8, 2011 with the christening of the new boat decked out with puzzle pieces sold to date. The festivities took place at the Farmington Crew Boat House at Tunxis Mead Park in Farmington. The FHS Crew Team hopes to raise awareness about the signs, diagnosis and treatment of the disorder.
